**Back-to-School Night:** Mark your calendars! Parent on Thursday, August 29, 2019 from 5:15 - 7:00 p.m. is our Back-to-School Night. Our amazing teachers will be on hand to provide important information regarding their classroom, included in their presentation will be information on curriculum, expectations for the year, academic and behavioral standards and ways in which you may be able to participate in your child's education. We will have a brief meeting in the auditorium from 5:15 - 6:00 p.m. to discuss some topics important to our school such as attendance, new staff, Parent Portal, and other volunteering opportunities. Ms. Camp will be here from our Local District parent unit to help with Parent Portal registrations. Your child's teacher will be presenting at 6:00 p.m. and will repeat the presentation again at 6:30 p.m. to accommodate families with children in multiple grade spans. Please plan on attending and we hope to see you there!

<u>Initial ELPAC Assessments</u>: Our new English Learners will soon be administered the Initial ELPAC Assessments. This test will give us a baseline measure of where your child is in acquiring fluency in English. Students will be given the annual ELPAC assessment

Admissions Day and Labor Day Holiday: In observance of Admissions Day, the school will be closed on Friday, August 30, 2019. In observance of Labor Day, the school will be closed on Monday, September 2, 2019. Classes will <u>resume</u> on Tuesday, September 3, 2019 at 8:10 a.m. with a dismissal time of 1;35 p.m. Please mark your calendars!

2019–20 Meal Applications: Parents and families, meal applications were mailed to our returning families before school began. If you have not already received an application via U.S. mail or from our school, you can get a *Meal Application* from the Main Office and from our Cafeteria Manager (Noune). We strongly encourage all parents/guardians to submit a *Meal Application* regardless if you believe your child/children will not qualify based on your current income level. Completing an application takes less than 10 minutes, and parents only need to complete one *Meal Application*. If you have a child/children in different schools, you still only need to complete and return one application. *Meal Applications* may also be submitted online at <u>www.myschoolapps.com</u>. Once you submit an application, you will receive a notice in the mail as to whether your child/children can receive free or reduced-price meals. (Please note: Submitting a meal application). EVERY ELIGIBLE FORM COUNTS! Every eligible form that is not submitted means lost resources for our schools.

Please note that it is important for all our families to complete a meal application, whether you choose to have your child eat from the Cafeteria or not. Full participation in this process helps to ensure potential re-allocation of and eligibility for Title I funding for our school. This year is our baseline year and will determine Title I eligibility for the next four years. If you have not done so, please complete an application today! If you already filled out a meal application – Thank you! Please do not fill out a paper application if you already applied online (It is one or the other – <u>not</u> both!).
